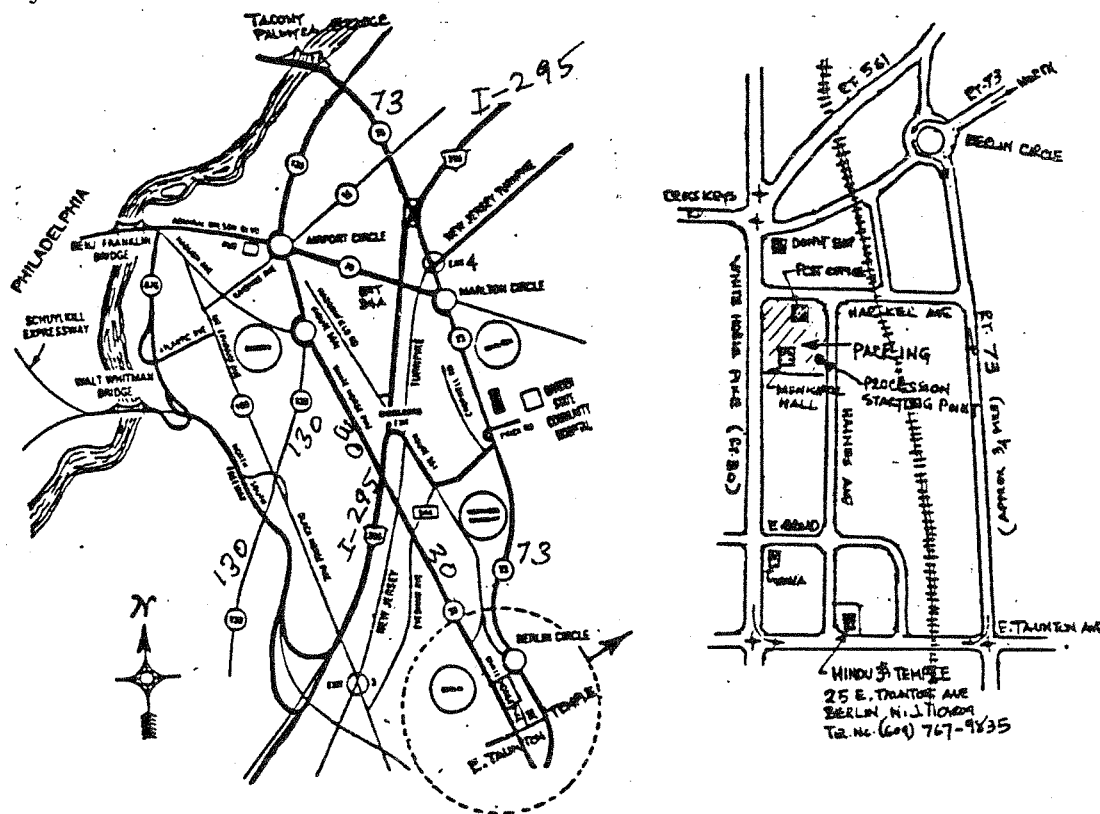

SRUTI proudly announces another major cultural event, a classical music concert by **Sri Bhimsen Joshi on September 22, 1990** at Drexel Hill Middle School, Upper Darby, PA 19082.

Lalgudi Srimathy hails from a family of distinguished musicians. One of her forefathers was a disciple of saint Thyagaraja. She received her early training in violin from her father who was a versatile musician. Her principal teacher was her brother, the violin virtuoso Lalgudi G. Jayaraman. For over a decade she teamed with her illustrious brother for concerts all over India. Today Srimathy is a solo artiste in her own right. Currently she is visiting the S.V. Temple at Pittsburgh to give lessons and perform concerts.

Prakash Rao is familiar to many of us. He received his initial training from Sudharsana Acharyulu of Hyderabad. Later he was trained by the famous mridangist Vellore Ramabadrana. He has accompanied Trichur Ramachandran, O.S. Thyagarajan and B. Rajam Iyer her in the USA. He accompanied Sakuntala Srinivasan on mridangam during the Thyagaraja aradhana celebration. He currently lives in New Jersey .



Directions:

- A. Tacony Bridge: 1. NJ Route 73 South to Berlin Circle ±(17 miles). 2. Stay on Route 73 to next traffic light and turn right on E. Taunton Ave.
- B. Ben Franklin Br.: 1. Route 30 East to NJ Route 70 East to Marlon Circle ±(11 miles). 2. Turn right on NJ Route 73 South go to Berlin Circle and follow A.2.
- C. Walt Whitman Br.: 1. I-295 North 2. Exit 34A for Route 70 East to Marlon Circle. 3. Follow B.2, -
- D. Delaware Mem. Br.: 1. I-295 North. 2. Follow C.2, B.2,
- E. Central and North Jersey, N.Y.: 1. NJ Turnpike South. 2. Exit 4 for Route 73 South go to Berlin Circle and follow A.2.
- F. Atlantic City: 1. Atlantic City Expressway. 2. NJ Route 73 North (Blue Anchor, High Speed Line sign). 3. Pass Route 30, go about 1 mile and turn left on E. Taunton Ave. 3. If missed, go to Berlin Circle and follow A.2.

Parking: Park in the Temple parking lot, both sides on Haines Ave and opposite side on Taunton Ave. **DO NOT BLOCK THE DRIVE WAYS.**

Please drop off your passengers at the Temple and go on Haines Ave. two blocks to the Municipal Hall Parking where adequate parking is available. ITA will not be responsible, neither announce illegally parked cars if they are being towed away.
